
Are you aged 13-18?

About Bromham Youth Club

Bromham Youth Club is a self-funded club that has been running since October 2015.

It is open to everyone aged 13 to 18 providing social, sports and creative activities for the children of Bromham and the surrounding villages/towns.

We welcome those aged 11 to 12 but can only take a small number as initial funding is in the main for 13 to 18 year olds.

The youth club is accessible to disabled young people as the building is on ground level with a wide entrance and suitable toilet facilities.

Entry is FREE for the first session, then only £1 after!

As well as many activities on offer of an evening, we will organise themed sessions (Easter, Halloween, Xmas etc.) as well as educational workshops/talks and trips away (e.g. Theme Parks, Theatre, Trampoline Park, Ice skating).

We also have fund-raising events that the members help to organise and participate in to ensure the club continues to run.

Bromham Youth Club enables young people to socialise, take part in new diverse activities, have fun and be safe.

When and Where We Meet

The one evening per week youth club meets at the Bromham Social Centre on New Road in Bromham every Wednesday from 7.30 to 9.30pm except on the second week of the month when it's on a Tuesday.

We operate in line with the school terms and are therefore closed during the holidays.

Energetic sports like dodgeball, football, volleyball, badminton and hockey to a more peaceful evening of art and crafts, board games or cards.
