We will write to the owners of all the sites that were put forward for consideration explaining the outcome of the assessment for their site and giving them the option to withdraw their site from further consideration and hence public scrutiny.

For the sites which are potentially suitable we will make it clear to the landowner that we are looking at how to provide affordable housing, as that is what our research has shown residents want to see in Bromham.

**Greg:** Draft the letters to those whose sites have been assessed as potentially suitable / unsuitable for further consideration in the NP process. Then circulate to the group for comment & approval. Target date for circulation 18/8/20, with the aim of getting the letters out by the next meeting.

With the letter we will send each landowner the detailed assessment of their site showing the basis for the decision.
