One interesting response was about including the needs of horse riders in our footpaths & cycling section. We should consider that in the 'route-ways' assessment.

We are now in a position to launch the consultation on community facilities. The plan here is simply to present the draft document and ask for feedback via Facebook & the website contact page. Our aim is to start this from the beginning of June.
